

MINUTES OF THE THIRD CIRCLE COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 23.03.2018 IN THE CONFERENCE HALL O/o CGMT, TELANGANA TELECOM CIRCLE, DOOR SANCHAR BHAVAN, HYDERABAD.

GM (HR & Admin) welcomed the Chief General Manager Telecom and Chairman of the CCM and other senior officers of Management side, staff side Secretary, staff side Leader and all the members to the 3rd CCM of Telangana Telecom Circle. He requested to popularize BSNL new schemes WINGS to increase the revenue. He assured to solve all the staff side issues and requested staff side members to cooperate for smooth functioning of the meeting. After that self introduction of all the members was done.

CGMT & Chairman of the CCM welcomed all the members to the 3rd Circle Council Meeting. CGMT said that there is a stiff competition in Telecom sector and everybody should work hard to increase the BSNL revenue and asked to maintain good image of the BSNL. CGMT in his opening remarks intimated that the combined AP & Telangana Circle stood first in CM sales revenue for the first time across India and crossed Kerala Telecom Circle in CM revenue and requested to put the same efforts in future for increasing the revenue. CGMT also informed that Telangana Telecom Circle has started BSNL 4G in all SSAs of Telangana except Hyderabad and a total of 125 BSNL 4G sites were commissioned. CDOT NGN sites migration is in progress and out of 49 sites, 43 sites already migrated and commissioned. CDOT NGN will be started at Ameerpet from Monday i.e. 25-03-2019. MNP negative growth brought to -10% during February 2019 and it will be positive during the month of March 2019. With a happy note CGMT intimated that in FTTH, 1000 connections were crossed during February 2019 and it will cross the target of 2000 connections in this month. With all positive things happening, CGMT expressed that next financial year will be fruitful and BSNL will have bright future. CGMT emphasized for a fruitful and smooth conduction of the meeting.

Staff Side Leader Sri. A. Rajamouli at the outset thanked CGMT for conducting the CCM. He congratulated management for completing Compassionate ground appointments. He stated that staff side will extend full cooperation to the management in the development of BSNL. In his remarks, pointed out call drops of mobile signals, utilization of vacant buildings, proper maintenance of copper/ fibre cables across Telangana circle and touched upon regarding the wages to casual mazdoors. He requested that the CCM meetings may be held regularly in CGM Office at least quarterly.

Staff side Secretary Sri J.Sampath Rao thanked CGMT for taking initiation to conduct the proposed 3rd CCM. He congratulated Civil & Electrical wings for completing the pending works at Aasman Mahal/ CGM office, Hyderabad and requested to complete remaining works at SSA level accordingly. He also brought to the kind notice of CGMT that Postpaid plans should be attractive to the customers and requested to retain all postpaid customers with BSNL only. He remarked that in some areas FTTH connections were provided on closing the existing broadband connections. This should not happen in future and asked management to give separate targets for Broadband and FTTH connections. He suggested that all CSCs should be maintained in neat & healthy condition. He asked CGMT to solve all pending items of old CCM positively.

DGM (Admin) welcomed all the members and started agenda items for discussion.

After the discussion of all the agenda points, Finally AGM (A), Convenor of CCM proposed the vote of Thanks.

AGENDA ITEMS OF 3rd CCM

1. After introduction of ERP, it has come to the notice of the staff unions that the subscriptions of **Postal Life Insurance (PLI)** of the staff deducted from the salary are not being credited in the Postal Department. Therefore, it may please be ensured that the recoveries schedules of PLI, from the beginning month of ERP implementation are to be sent to the Postal Department immediately to avoid loss and difficulties to employees, at the maturity of the policies.

ACTION BY: DGM (F&A) CO

ACTION TAKEN:

The required Schedules of PLI premiums w.e.f 01.08.2014 to 28.02.2019 were already sent to the Asst. Divisional Manager (PLI) O/o CPMG, Hyd with a copy to the Sr. Post Master, HPO, Khairatabad regularly for taking further updation at their end pl.

Staff side requested to verify the details of updation in MBN, NGD SSAs. Sr.GM (Finance) has assured to look into the issue and resolve.

2. **Civil & Electrical Maintenance repairs to office buildings and staff quarters etc**, in all districts in Telangana circle, which are pending for quite some time are to be taken up and to get them repaired immediately. In this regard, the lifts in Asman Mahal P&T quarters, Hyderabad and GM office Nizamabad etc, are also be got repaired.

ACTION BY : CE(CIVIL/ELECTRICAL) CO

ACTION TAKEN:

The Civil maintenance works in TE/ Admn & staff quarters in respective SSAs are being taken up on need basis based on requisition & sanctions issued for the estimates by the SSAs.

In Asman Mahal, Hyderabad

1. Day to day maintenance of Asmanmahal quarters: As and when complaints are received, the same are attended under Annual maintenance tender.
2. Providing Bore well in Asmanmahal qtrs: There was no response to two earlier calls. The work awarded now. The Agency not started the work due to pending payments.
3. Renovation of drainage work in Asmanmahal compound: Work completed in all respects.

In Asman Mahal Hyderabad, two new lifts are installed and in-operation in B & F-blocks.

In GM Office Nizamabad, the old lift was scrapped. The material for new lift was received and same is under installation process. As per vendor, work will be completed subject to release of RA payments (Rs 13,31,520/-bill is pending in CSC fund sought during Feb 2019) as per agreement terms against supply of material.

3. Telephone Exchanges below 10 lines may be closed and these lines may be connected / linked to the adjacent feasible Telephone Exchanges to avoid electricity bills, building rents, and the staff working at these exchanges(below 10 lines) can be better utilized in needy stations in the SSA in consultation with the unions.

ACTION BY: GM(NWO-CFA)CO / ALL SSA HEADS

ACTION TAKEN:

- (a) Exchanges below 10 DELs closed during 2017-18 = 49

DECISION TAKEN:

It was decided that left out Exchanges with a capacity of below 20 lines, which are not closed during 2018-19 (approximately 60) will be observed in all respects of revenue for next six months and action will be taken based on the feedback.

(ITEM CLOSED)

4. The Customer service Centers which are in receipt of low revenue may be closed immediately to minimize electricity bills, rents and the staff working in these centers may be deployed in needy places in consultation of the unions.

ACTION BY: GM(NWO-CFA)CO / ALL SSA HEADS

ACTION TAKEN:

As per decision taken in 2nd CCM, details of CSC wise revenue collection from SSAs was collected from April 2018 to January 2019.

DECISION TAKEN:

It was decided that in all SSAs low revenue generating CSCs will be reviewed by SSA Heads and further actions will be taken regarding closure. As Medchal was made a District Headquarter, re-opening of CSC will be considered after reviewing the CSC revenue of Medchal generated during FY 2017-18 by HTD.

5. Information sought for by the Corporate Office on important staff matters may please be sent immediately without any further delay : Information regarding the number of TSMs regularized on or after 1.10.2000 and covered under Rule 37A of CCS Pension rules, for granting 1 st NEPP at par with DoT absorbed employees—(a) Total number of the employees for whom this benefit is to be extended at par with DoT absorbed employees (b) Total financial implication including pension liability (Reminder-III issued by Corporate Office vide No.22-23/2012-TE dated 21.5.2018)

ACTION BY: AGM(Admn) CO / DGM(F&A) CO

ACTION TAKEN:

The information regarding TSMs regularized on or after 1.10.2000 and covered under Rule 37A of CCS pension rules for granting 1st NEPP at par with DOT absorbed employees is here with enclosed as annexure "A". The approximate financial implication is Rs 2,06,55,718/- in Telangana circle. The letter sent to BSNL CO ND vide letter TT/STC/5-6/2016-19/110 Dated 9.8.2018

(ITEM CLOSED)

6. Provision of PC with printer and broadband internet facility to Circle/District Union Offices of Recognized Unions along with Intranet facility as per the guidelines of corporate office. In some SSAs PC, printer and broadband internet and intranet facilities are not provided. It is requested to cause necessary action for providing these facilities immediately.

ACTION BY: GM(BP&IT)/GM(NWO-CFA) CO / ALL SSA HEADS

ACTION TAKEN:

Four printers were procured by IT wing of Circle Office for allotment to Circle Unions and Circle office branch unions. (i.e., BSNLEU & NFTE). Two printers were installed at BSNLEU Circle Union office and branch union office. NFTE has given a letter for non-requirement of printers.

As per BSNL CO ND guidelines, Broadband connection can be extended to recognized unions to the existing Landlines or new LL with BBG combo ULD599 plan at Circle level and BBG Combo ULD 499 plan at SSA level. If the union office is located in BSNL premises and LAN network is provided no separate BB connection can be extended.

PC printer along with broadband facility was provided in all the SSAs except at Nizamabad & Karimnagar. In KAA SSA, only PC with broadband provided, printer will be supplied as and when procured. In NZB SSA, PC & Printers are not yet provided due to lack of items. Instructed the SSA to provide the PC & Printer immediately and report compliance.

Staff side has complained PC & Printer was not provided at MBN & WL SSAs.

DECISION TAKEN:

It was decided to take compliance report from Warangal/ Mahaboobnagar and Karimnagar SSAs.

7. Implementation of revision of minimum wage rates to the casual mazdoors as per the corporate office orders vide C.O.ND NO.2-2/(Mise/Revised wage rate/2018-WS&I dated 23-05-2018: Corporate office has circulated minimum revised wage rates w.e.f 1-4-2018. This may be implemented in all SSAs of Telangana circle.

ACTION BY: AGM(Admn) CO / DGM(F&A) CO

ACTION TAKEN:

As per CO BSNL Order no. 11-3/2016-LE dt 25.10.2018 (copy enclosed), the revision of the wages of Casual Mazdoors will be done at the time of pay revision of non-executive employees.
(ITEM CLOSED)

8. In service training to Telecom Technician & Junior Engineer cadres: The said staff working in FTTH/Broad Band segment, which is based on latest technology, are not given any basic training so that the staff can attend and restore the problems within a reasonable time. We therefore request the administration to kindly initiate to prepare action plan for training the field staff in fiber jointing and fiber modem on configuration to restore faults efficiently.

ACTION BY: PRINCIPAL RTTC / AGM(SR&Trg) CO

ACTION TAKEN:

RTTC-HD has conducted practical-oriented training to "train THE TRAINERS PROGRAM ON OPTICAL FIBRE CABLE SPLICING AND MAINTENANCE "at RTTC,HD during the period 08.01.18 to 10.1.18 for three days with the objective of imparting the same training to the non-executives in their respective SSAs. 18 officers were participated in that training.

However, only few SSAs (ADB &HTD) have conducted the Field training programmes (FTPs) and the turnout is low. The RTTC, HD has coordinated in the conduction of the FTPs on OF cable splicing & FTTH during the year 2018 in TT Circle and the participants were 216 only.

The RTTC,HD is always ready to impart the trainings to the BSNL non-executives and executives on OFC/FTTH related training programmes. In this regard RTTC,HD has conducted the training courses on OFC splicing and FTTH maintenance / Broadband configuration during the month of Jan'19.

DECISION TAKEN:

It was decided to issue instructions to all SSAs with a target to train maximum number of TT & JE atleast 50 from each SSA in Telangana Telecom Circle in FTPs on OF cable splicing & FTTH maintenance / Broadband configuration during the year 2019-20.

(ITEM CLOSED)

9. Provision of gate to Husnabad Telephone Exchange in Karimnagar district: There is no proper gate available to enter into CSC and Exchange. Now, the passage to our exchange is through revenue office. If they close the gate of revenue office, there is no way to us to enter exchange. The existing gate was constructed without any proper plan. Even, subscribers are also feeling inconvenient to enter to CSC/exchange. We request the administration to take suitable action in the matter by providing separate gate without interference of revenue office at Husnabad to avoid inconvenient to our staff and subscribers. The staff quarters were also available in the exchange premises.

ACTION BY: GM KAA / CE(CIVIL) CO

ACTION TAKEN:

Estimate submitted for new gate at Husnabad TE for an amount of Rs 1.79 Lakhs on 2.1.2019. The new gate work requires permission of Revenue authorities since there is disputed property on back side of our compound where gate is proposed. The existing entrance gate was provided as per the approved layout of compound during construction of compound wall/building.

DECISION TAKEN:

It was decided to obtain detailed report from Karimnagar SSA.

10. Renewal of Empaneled Hospitals and Non denial of BSNL MRS Beneficiaries by the Empaneled Hospitals: After expiring the MOU period limit with empanelled hospital, the administration at Karimnagar and Nizamabad were sending simply without any proper documents/records for renewal of hospitals. By this the employees in the SSAs are suffering very a lot. We request you to kindly give instructions to the General Managers concerned that the proposal for renewal of existing hospitals with proper documents should be sent to Circle office to avoid hardships to our employees. Needful action is needed in the matter.

It is brought to the notice of this union notice members that some of the Hospital under BSNLMRS empanel list are denying the admission into the hospital for medical treatment and insisting the officials to pay the initial deposit in violation of MOU agreement by the hospitals. We therefore request the administration to issue necessary instructions to all the empanel hospitals under BSNLMRS not to deny any BSNL employee or retired employee for cashless indoor treatment as per the MOU agreement without demanding for any deposit from the staff.

ACTION BY: AGM(SR&Trg) CO / ALL SSA HEADS

ACTION TAKEN:

Instructions are being issued to SSAs from time to time to send the required documents for new/renewal of empaneled hospitals. Due to Financial crunch this situation has come and approval was conveyed to enter into MOU.

Instructions were issued to empaneled hospitals not to deny for the admission into hospital for medical treatment and payment of initial deposit.

DECISION TAKEN:

It was decided, proper instructions will be given to all SSAs for renewal of empaneled hospitals. It will be started at least six months before the expiry of MOU.

(ITEM CLOSED)

11. Maintenance of quarters at GodavariKhani (KAA SSA): The maintenance of quarters is very poor, particularly the quarters of STR in the compound were very pitiable condition. It rain comes water level be 3 to 4 feet in front of quarters. The staff residing in the quarters are under threat with snakes. We brought the same to the notice of concerned authorities for action. No suitable action was taken to clear the water permanently in the rainy season. We request you kindly do needful in the matter.

ACTION BY: GM KAA / CE(CIVIL) CO

ACTION TAKEN:

EE (Civil), Warangal has intimated that the rear side area of compound, especially STR quarters and C-B block quarters area got inundated during this rainy season. The ground level at rear side of the compound is about 2.10m below the ground level at front side and all the water gets accumulated in this area during rainy season. The ground level at rear side is also about 0.40 m below adjacent road level and as such all the storm water cannot be drained out. If the ground level is raised inside the compound, the storm water will enter into the quarters as the plinth levels is not high since the quarters were constructed long back.

The size of existing U/G municipal drain on the backside of compound is of 6" dia. & it is clogged and not catering to required capacity. SSA has taken up the matter with the local Municipality for replacing existing municipal drainage line with higher dia. pipes on the rear side of compound and also to permit to connect our drainage pipelines of our quarters and also storm water drains to the municipal drainage line so that stagnation of water doesn't occur in the compound. DE, Godavarikhani met municipal authorities & discussed regarding increasing the size of municipal drain & permission to connect to storm water drain. Municipal authorities said they will look into the matter. DE informed that met Municipal Authorities, but issue still not resolved.

For the other Civil works in the compound, after no response to 2 calls, tender has been awarded on 28.01.2019. Work not started due to non-release of contractor's pending payments. Target date for completion is 31.05.2019.

DECISION TAKEN:

It was decided to construct compound wall or any alternative method from Karimnagar SSA. The detailed inspection report may be obtained from CE (Civil) for further action.

12. Issuance of MRS Cards to staff in Nizamabad SSA: The issue is pending in the SSA since long time. The administration is not taking any efforts to supply MRS cards to eligible staff in the SSA, sometimes it is causing much hardship to staff for medical permission. **ACTION BY: GM NZB**

ACTION TAKEN:

MRS cards were issued to all the employees in the Nizamabad SSA. **(ITEM CLOSED)**

13. Providing of furniture in Zonal offices in Hyderabad district: BSNL is in Corporate office status, but the zonal offices/SDOP offices were not having minimum furniture to sit in the office. For purchasing the minimum requirement the Hyderabad district have written a letter in detail for permission to purchase them. We request you to take action to provide minimum furniture in zonal/SDOP offices in Hyderabad.

ACTION BY: PGM HTD

ACTION TAKEN:

Sufficient furniture is available in Zonal offices. Wherever shortage is there local arrangement is being done

DECISION TAKEN:

It was decided to rearrange sufficient furniture in Zonal offices wherever shortage is there.

(ITEM CLOSED)

14. It has come to the notice of the all unions that the New phone connections are not being provided to the BSNL serving employees under WE-DOT/BSNL category by the SSA concerned on the plea that non-availability cable and non-feasibility. As per the corporate office guidelines, all the serving employees of BSNL are eligible to get service connection under WE-DOT/BSNL category. In case UG cable or any infra is not available at the station where serving employee desires to get the connection, FTTH connection may be provided. Hence, the staff side requests the administration to give necessary instructions to the SSAs concerned to provide the FTTH connection where ever UG cable is not available to provide the connections under WEDOT connections.

ACTION BY: GM(NWO-CFA)CO / ALL SSA HEADS

ACTION TAKEN:

SSAs are providing FTTH connections in TNF areas to WEDOT/ BSNL category employees with the permission of Head of SSA. **(ITEM CLOSED)**

1st CCM Pending Points

Item no : 4 Request for replacement of drainage pipelines at all staff quarters and offices at Karimnagar SSA:

The drainage pipe lines at staff quarters and office buildings almost in damaged condition in Karimnagar SSA particularly at GM office building, the drainage water from bath rooms entering in to the corridor due to stagnation in the pipe line. The GM peshi and commercial sections where customers are regularly coming is affected with bad smell. The staff quarters are also effected with this stagnation and the families are suffering. Request early action in this issue immediately.

Staff side expressed its dissatisfaction over non settlement of pending works pertaining to civil/electrical at SSAs level years together and strongly demanded that all pending items including lift at Asman Mahal Quarters, Hyd should be completed on priority basis before Deepavali.

ACTION BY : GMTD KAA SSA /CE(CIVIL/ELECTRICAL)

ACTION TAKEN:

SE(Civil), EE(Civil) and SDE(Civil) had attended meeting on 02.04.2018 in the chambers of DGM (Plg), O/o The GMTD, Karimnagar wherein DGM(Plg&CM), AGM(Plg) and representatives of Unions were also present. They also visited all the floors of GMTD building at Karimnagar. Subsequently work has been completed in all respects in GMTD Building, Karimnagar.

Repair work completed in K.S.Lane Compound & debris cleaning in progress. In Asman Mahal compound, repair work & new drainage line for short length completed.

All the Officers also visited the Saptagiri quarters compound. It was observed that dried leaves are lying in the compound. Building in Charge was requested to do housekeeping of the compound so that the compound remains cleared of dried leaves and debris. Water pipeline work is completed since it was priority work as per occupants.

Regarding other miscellaneous items, the earlier contract had to be terminated due to non-performance by contractor. For these works tender to be called.

DECISION TAKEN:

It was decided for pending miscellaneous items works tender to be called.

(ITEM CLOSED)

8. Shifting of Customer Service Centre, Kamareddy from the rented building to our own building at STR quarters Nizam sagar Road, Kamareddy where sufficient place is available.

ACTION BY : GMTD NZB/CE(civil),CO HD

ACTION TAKEN:

There was no response to tender in 3 earlier calls. Subsequently work executed through works order & electrical works completed. All civil works except painting completed recently. Work of shifting of counters to be taken up. Target date for completion of work is 20.04.2019.

11. BSNL Empanelment of Private Hospitals:

Vide BSNL Corporate office Lr.No. BSNL/Admn I/15-14/11 dated 12-3-2013 where in it was clarified that BSNL can follow the policy followed earlier till any guidance is received from CGHS, where CGHS recognized or NABH accredited hospitals are not available. However, the rates applicable shall be as per Non-NABH rates notified by the CGHS for that area or rates of the hospital, whichever is less. Accordingly Circle office has also issued a letter to SSA Heads to get private hospitals who are willing to come forward to get empanelment with BSNL for extending medical facilities under BSNLMRS to BSNL Employees as well as BSNL Pensioners. But, Khammam Local Management has not shown the interest to get the hospitals with BSNL. At present, no BSNL empanelment hospital or CGHS hospital is available at Khammam. The BSNL employees and Pensioners are being faced much difficulties to take the treatment at other places in simple cases. It is requested to issue necessary instructions to Khammam Management to get the same.

Staff side members requested that provisional permissions for empanelment of private hospitals who are willing to come forward for BSNL empanelment at Khammam / Warangal / Nalgonda will be issued since there is no hospital under BSNL empanelment at present.

ACTION TAKEN:

A letter addressed to BSNL CO seeking clarification whether hospitals can be empanelled without AERB certificate. Meanwhile a provisional permission for 6 months has been given to APARNA HOSPITAL Nalgonda on 4.6.2018. In Khammam, MAMATHA SUPER SPECIALITY HOSPITAL and in Warangal JAYA HOSPITALS& SHARAT EYE HOSPITAL were empanelled.

(ITEM CLOSED)

2nd CCM Pending Points

1. Closure of cost-ineffective CSCs: Due to reduction in landline connections in entire circle, operation of CSCs with less TR collections has become saddle to the organization. Irrespective of TR collection, payment of power bill, housekeeping, rent in case CSC is located in private buildings is inevitable apart from the PCs and printers. More particularly considerable number of staff members in group-c cadre are retiring month on month in all SSAs, meaningful deployment is to be done on need basis in profit earning zones. Keeping in view of these points, staff side requests to analyze the matter on money-spinning basis and all the CSCs with lesser collections may be closed before the new financial year begins.
