Sub:- Release of two instalments of Industrial Dearness Allowance in respect of Non-Executive employees of BSNL -Reg.

Respected Sir,

It is respectfully submitted that the Department of Public Enterprise vide circular dated 19th November has freezed the two instalments of IDA due w.e.f. 01-10-2020 and 01.01.2021 as well as forfeiting the accrued arrears up to 30th June 2021. The unilateral orders have been issued forgetting that the PSUs including BSNL don't get budgetary support from Govt. of India. The employees receive the wages from the internal resources of the PSUs. The freezing orders thus have been illogical and illegal and issued in haste.

We may apprise you, sir, in the writ petition no. WC26423 filed in Kerala Hon'ble High Court against the impugned order the Additional Solicitor General GOI submitted the freezing orders are not applicable in respect of non-executive employees.

It is, therefore, urged that the DPE be directed release all frozen installments of IDA and protect the low paid employees from sufferings.
