I am directed to refer your letter cited under reference regarding trade union action.

You have requested for cancellation of transfer orders issued to Shri C. Venkatesh, ATT, Sangareddy BA and Shri G. Venkateswar Reddy, TT, Warangal BA. This office has advised BA Heads of WGL BA & SGD BA to follow guidelines issued by BSNL CO-ND and by this office vide Lr. No. TT/STC/7-1/2016-18/87 Dated at Hyd the 16.03.2018 and its corrigendum dated 01.05.2018.

Further, it is informed that management has been serious about the important issues raised by unions. Every effort is being made proactively to address the grievance of employees.

Since, BSNL is passing through a challenging phase as such any agitation activity at this juncture will not be in the interest of BSNL. It is imperative for all employees to focus on the improvement of productivity and financial condition of the company.

Presently BSNL is focusing on its revival. Any trade union action affects the company in two ways. (i) Any type of such activities may cast bad image of the company in the eyes of customers. (ii) Causes loss of man-hours, affecting adversely the productivity and the general discipline. This also defeats the sincere efforts which are being made by the Govt. management and employees for the revival of BSNL.

In view of above facts, it is requested to withdraw the proposed trade union action and focus on work for the growth of the company.
